Requirements:

- All information presented by participants should be guided by the Forum's principles of constructive and respectful dialogue.
- The requesting organization will be responsible for the table/stand during the meeting hours for the duration of the Forum.
- Distribution of material elsewhere in the University el Externado is not permitted, including in the cafeteria and other public spaces.
- Materials containing abusive or offensive language or images are not permitted.
- Using the stand for promoting commercial services is not permitted. Only promotion of publicly available material and resources is accepted.
- The decoration of the stand, whether with banners or other distinctive elements, is entirely optional and is the responsibility of the organization. Please note that there will be no power supply for the connection of electronic equipment.
- It is not necessary to stay at the stand all the time, materials can be left in the stand unattended during the sessions, and come back for the breaks
